Position Summary

Two part-time family program facilitators, one in New Denver and one in Nakusp, to run a Songs of Mother Goose program. We are looking for someone with experience managing small groups of parents with their children, ages birth – 5 years. It is possible for both of these positions to be filled by one person.

Songs of Mother Goose is a fun weekly program during which caregivers and children/babies engage in rhymes, songs, and stories.

Qualifications and Attributes

- Strong communication skills with adults and children
- Confident singing with children
- Able to facilitate group discussions
- Flexible and motivated
- Understanding of early learning and early literacy skills
- Responsible

Responsibilities

- Plan and deliver Songs of Mother Goose program to young children and their caregivers
- Set up and take down program sites as needed – facilitators may need to move tables, chairs and equipment
- Provide participants with resources and referrals to community services
- Attend professional development sessions, community meetings and staff meetings as required
- Ensure required participant documents are completed and submitted to the coordinator

Hours & Wages

Each position will start at 2 hours per week and may work into more depending on availability, interest, and skill set. Starting wage is \$21 per hour.
